Petition for Degrees

To the Petitioner

As you have expressed a desire to become a Freemason, you should consider thoroughly the step you propose to take. The exact nature of the Institution being unknown to you, we consider it advisable that you should be informed on certain points, which may affect your decision to apply for membership.

Freemasonry has, in all ages, insisted that men shall come to its doors of their own free will, not as the result of solicitations, not from feelings of curiosity, but from a favorable opinion of the Institution and a desire to be ranked among its members.

Freemasonry is a system of morality based on the belief of the existence of God, the immortality of the soul, and the brotherhood of man; therefore, no atheist can be a Mason. It strives to teach a man the duty he owes to God, his country, his family, his neighbor, and himself. It interferes with neither religion nor politics.

Loyalty to one's country is an essential qualification in Freemasonry. Disloyalty in any form is abhorrent to the teachings of the Fraternity and is regarded as a serious Masonic offense. Freemasonry is not contrary to the beliefs of any man of upright heart and mind, and has in it nothing that is inconsistent with his civic, moral, or religious duties.

Freemasonry is not to be sought in the hope of personal gain or advancement. Anyone so motivated will be disappointed. The aim of the true Freemason is to cultivate a brotherly feeling among men and to help whomsoever he can. Freemasonry does not provide sick or death benefits. It is not an insurance order. Masonic charity is intended for those who, from unforeseen circumstances, and through no fault of their own, have met with misfortune.

After reading the above, if you desire to petition for the Degrees of Freemasonry, you may fill out the following petition and submit it to the Lodge. (It is not necessary to read this to the Lodge when receiving the petition.)

TO THE LODGE:

Effective September 1, 1991, no Lodge in Wyoming shall receive a petition for the Degrees of Freemasonry unless it is submitted in this form.

This petition must be retained as a permanent record of your Lodge.
